TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Rates include Tourism Levy, VAT and 6% Concession Fee, collected by Sikereti Camps + Safaris (Pty) Limited (Sikereti Camp) for the Khaudum North Complex Conservancy and the Gciriku Traditional Authority. Rates are quoted in Namibian Dollars (NAD), and may be changed without prior notice.

Rates for SADC citizens and residents, as indicated, are approximately 30% less than rack. Documentary proof is required to avail of this discount. Children age 6 - 12 pay half price. Children under 6 stay free if sharing with parents. No more than two children may share a tent with parents. Provision for children sharing with adults will be made upon arrival, but has to be booked in advance. Adult rates apply for children staying in their own tent.

Bookings are only confirmed when paid in full. Cancellations received at least 30 days prior to arrival are fully refundable. No refunds are available for confirmed bookings cancelled less than 30 days before arrival.

Tour operators in Namibia and abroad, registered with the NTB, qualify for commission at the discretion of Sikereti Camp. Meals and activities, including game drives, are non-commissionable.

Guests arriving without pre-paid accommodation are

required to settle all payments in cash as there are no credit card or electronic payment facilities at Sikereti Camp. Extras, such as meals, activities, drinks and laundry have to be settled at Sikereti Camp and cannot be pre-paid.

Sikereti Camp offers self-catering and full board. Each of the tented units has a covered outdoor braai and wash-up area. Utensils, cutlery and crockery are not provided for self-catering guests.

Transfers to/from the camp is excluded from the rack rates. Pick-up from Tsumkwe or Sikereti Gate should be arranged prior to arrival. Contact Sikereti Camp for rates.

Guests at Sikereti Camp are required to have their own travel insurance. Should they not have insurance cover, they will be personally responsible for any costs incurred as a result of a medical emergency or evacuation, as well as any other insurance claims.

Visitors are required to report and register immediately upon entry to the Park at Sikereti Gate, if entering from the south, or Khaudum Gate, if entering from the north. Park Entrance, Conservation and vehicle fees due to the Ministry of Environment, Forestry and Tourism (MEFT) should be settled at the gate upon arrival, unless such fees have been paid to Sikereti Camp prior to arrival. Proof of pre-payment will be required at the gate.

Visitors assume full responsibility and liability for their safety and conduct, and by entering the Park expressly and irrevocably waive and renounce all claims against the Government of the Republic of Namibia, MEFT, Khaudum National Park and Sikereti Camp for loss, damages, or injury howsoever sustained whilst in the Park. Guest will be required to complete an indemnity form upon arrival at Sikereti Camp.
